


About Kang Fu Center

Will it hurt?

Most patients describe their treatment as virtually painless —less painful than plucking out a hair for example. Some patients feel nothing at all.

Is it safe?

Acupuncture is safe when performed by a qualified licensed practitioner. (Our practice uses disposable needles)

What will happen in my consultation?

Your practitioner will ask about your medical history and will assess your appearance (such as your body shape, the color of your tongue, and the quality of your pulse). Your practitioner may test for muscle weakness or weaknesses along your meridians. From there they will develop a treatment plan specifically for your situation.

Is acupuncture covered by insurance?

Yes, since 1985 health care plan services, non profit hospital service plans, automobile insurance, workman s compensation and disability insurance policies have offered acupuncture coverage.

What insurance plans do you accept?
